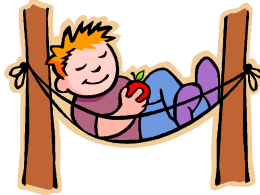


1st Grade News

Reading: Our story this week is The Storm. Please watch for the reading book in their backpack. This means to practice the story! ☺ Also review the new word list which will come home every Monday. This week we'll work with the short /i/ vowel sound and consonants /r/, /h/, /s/, /b/ and /g/.

Math: More work with addition. We'll learn to add vertically this week. Please practice math facts through the sum of 8 at home.

Spelling: See word list below. The practice test will be given on Wednesday. The test for a grade will be given on Friday.

English: This week we'll work with identifying incomplete sentences. We'll learn about question words.

Science: We'll compare living to non-living things. We'll review for our first Chapter test which we will have next week. (Grades will not be given for Science & Social Studies. First grade students receive instruction for the purpose of gaining basic understanding and increasing their knowledge base.) The tests are a great practice for 2nd grade!

Social Studies: We'll learn about government leaders and voting this week.
