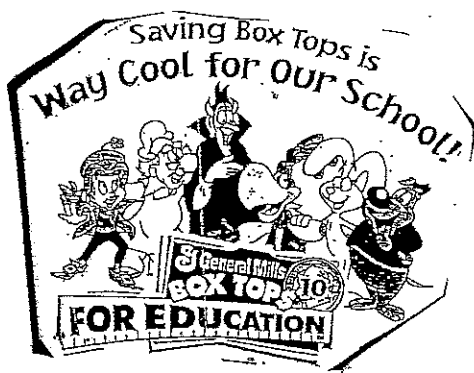

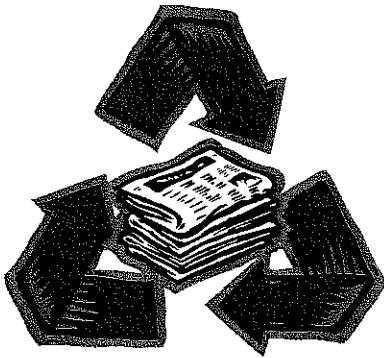

- Soft-cover Books, Telephone Books
- Newspapers, Magazines, Catalogs
