Reading: This week's story will be <u>Two Bear Cubs</u>. We will use this story to compare and contrast characters and actions of the characters in the story.

Math: We will be doing an online MAP Math Tutorial to practice using the online tools for our upcoming state assessments. We will be reviewing many concepts from over the course of the year as well as some skills from last year.
