Science: The students have been learning about inheritance and

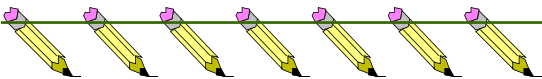


traits. We will continue working on investigating and writing scientific explanation this upcoming week.
