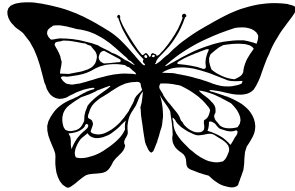

Coming up next week...

Reading: This week we will finish up our unit on alphabetizing. We will then move back into our next story, Destiny's Gift. We will use this story to work on identifying character traits and using story events to use information from the text as proof of the character traits.



Math: Unit 1 continues as we continue working on our multiplication and division facts of 5 and we will also work on 2s facts. **Continue working with your child to practice these facts; they are expected to be able to recall all facts up through 12s this year!**

Science: Unit 1 continues with force and motion as we look at investigating balanced forces as well as explaining and modeling how gravity is a pull toward the center of the earth.

Social Studies: Our class will begin talking about Missouri people and culture. This week we will be learning about different music and art found in our state. Our unit 1 test will be Friday.

English: Our unit next week will begin our narrative writing. We are using the story, Weslandia to discuss story elements when creating a narrative writing. We will begin with the introduction to our writing and work on adding details to make the writing more vivid.
