Outlook for Next Week...


Reading: Our quiz over the story, Pop's Bridge is currently scheduled for Monday next week. We will then be reading Creepy Carrots! With this short story, we will work on story sequencing, vocabulary, and cause and effect.

Math: We will continue working on multiplication facts, including multiplying by 2, 5, 10, 9, 3, and 4. We will work on problem solving and word problems this week as well.

Science: We will begin the last chapter of Unit 1 by investigating unbalanced forces. We will also be conducting a hoverboard experiment and use our activities to predict scientific patterns that we are seeing.

Social Studies: We will begin learning about Lewis and Clark. We will be reading books, watching videos, and looking at maps to learn all about their expedition.

English: We will continue working on The Essential 55 Rules as well as handwriting. We will also continue learning about narrative writing as we begin proofreading our paragraphs and editing our spelling, punctuation, and grammar.
