A Peek at Our Week

Reading story - What Can You Do? by: Shelley Rotner and Sheila Kelly

Reading skills - author's purpose, using context, and analyze/evaluate

Phonics skills - multisyllable words

Spelling - long vowel with r consonant (-are, -ere, -ire, -ore)

Grammar - adjectives

Writing - we will finish up writing poetry and finalize our professional book for publishing

Math - we will focus on learning multiple ways of adding two 2-digit numbers

Social Studies - we will begin our economics unit and learn about goods, services, producers, and consumers

Please be working with your child on:

- tying their shoes
- writing their name neatly
- quarter 4 sight words (read all 50 words in 2.5 minutes)

From now on, in reading, the students will be required to read 100% of the test on their own, if they haven't already been doing so. We are working towards independently taking the reading test by the end of the year. In second grade all students are expected to read the entire test and complete it themselves. This is our last step towards that. Be aware that grades will reflect your students independent reading ability.
