Reading - We have started reading from the Magic Treehouse series. Please do not read these at home unless I have sent a book home for your child to read. These books are set up to be read in order, so if your child reads ahead, they cannot work on the reading skills (predictions, inferring, problem/solution) we will be doing because they already know the answers, and (spoiler alert!) they spoil it for everyone else. No reading test this Friday. We will take a test at the end of book #2. I will let you know when that will be.

Spelling - None this week. We are finishing up on our instant syllable phonic skills.

English - We will be working with the conjunction words, and, but and so. We will learn when to use them! (not at the beginning of the sentences).

Math - We will start learning how to borrow, or the new term "ungroup", in subtraction. Most work will be done in class, since we will start with new methods, and will end up with the "old fashioned way" you learned. If your child has had flash cards sent home, please practice as often as possible. It really will help your child as we work with larger numbers to have their facts memorized.

Science - We will begin learning about the Earth's surface.

Social Studies - We will be sharing our books we make on the United States and will be sharing them with others.

Share Time - Bring an item that you received over the holiday break.
