Why do we have to do a 3-year re-evaluation?

01

It's Required by Law

Within the Missouri Standards and Indicators, it is required for schools to complete a re-evaluation every 3 years in order to decide if the student continues to qualify

02

Student Progress

It is a time where we can get new test scores to see where the student is performing at, so the team can get a new vision.

03

Check Qualification

See if the student continues to meet the requirements to be in special education

A Re-Evaluation can also be started by parent request or by teacher request if there is a need before the three-years comes around.

Step 1

Where is the Child Right Now?

Special Education teachers get information from all the child's teachers, and YOU to put together all the information in order for the team to figure out what areas the team needs more information in.

Meeting!

Step 2

*Meet with the whole team to talk the information from teachers and YOU, as well as, about what testing the child will need

Step 3

60 Day from
your signature
until final
Meeting

Testing

After you sign permission, your student will take the tests that the team decided at the meeting.

Meeting!

Step 4

*Meet together with the whole team to decide if the child qualifies for services and/or put in place interventions

So What?

If your student **qualifies**

After you sign permission for your student to be in special education...

The meeting will switch directly into an IEP Meeting

OR

An IEP Meeting will be scheduled within the next 30 days.

If your student does **not qualify**

You can choose to sign permission for your student to be taken out of Special Education before the 10 day waiting period.

Your student is no longer in Special Education and will receive all instruction and support within their regular classroom. Interventions in that classroom will be put into place.
