Reading –We are learning more sounds this week. Encourage your child to tell you what sounds they hear at the beginning of words. For instance, ask them “What words start with the *mmm* sound?”. We are also beginning to identify rhyming words.

Our theme this week is all about apples!

Math – This week we will learn how to represent the number 5. We are practicing counting to 100 by 1’s and 10’s. They should be able to identify and write the numbers 0-5 correctly.

Science–We will taste test different apples and learn about how they are grown.

Grammar – We will continue to learn about action verbs this week.

Handwriting – All kindergarteners should be able to write their first names and be practicing their last names. When helping your child practice writing, please remind them that capital letters should only be used at the beginning of a name with the rest of the letters being lowercase. This week we will learn K, L, and U.

Book Logs – Book logs will be due the last day of the month. Each child’s goal is 15 books, but they are encouraged to go above and beyond if they wish! Just let me know if they need another copy.
