Reading – We are continuing to work on beginning sounds. They are doing great at learning to identify these sounds and their letters! Keep practicing at home.

Our stories this week will focus on the seasons, with emphasis on fall.

Math – This week we will learn how to represent the numbers 6 and 7. Students should be able to write the numbers 0-7 correctly. Continue to practice counting to 100 by 1's and 10's at home.

Science – This week we will compare and contrast animals and plants.

Grammar – We will continue to study adjectives, which are words that describe things.

Handwriting – All kindergarteners should be able to write their first and last names correctly by the end of the year. This week we will learn V, W, X, and Y.
