Math:

We will continue working with geometry in Chapter 3 with Angles and Triangles. Next week, we will work with parallel lines and transversals.

ELA:

We will be doing a short unit on "The Thrill of Horror" genre using our *Collections* books. We will be reading scary stories and looking at how ellipses, dashes, and pictures play a role in this genre.

American History:

We will continue on with Ch. 4 "Colonial Development". We will have maps to complete, daily assignments, and will review what we know about the Magna Carta, English Bill of Rights, and Great Britain's government today (Constitutional Monarchy with Prime Minister, Parliament, and the Crown).
