Math:

ELA:

American History:

Our Ch. 7 test is set for Tues., Dec. 12th. You will need to review your notes and previous quizzes, study the flashcards on Quizlet.com, and review your textbook prior to the test! We will then begin Unit 4: "The Early Republic", Ch. 8 "Growing Pains in the New Republic: 1789-1844". The plan is to test over Ch. 8 on Dec. 18th and take your States and Capitals test on Dec. 19th.

Science:

We dove into our new unit: Light waves! We are going to take on the role of student spectroscopists tasked with answering the question, Why is the skin cancer rate in Australia so high? Students will develop a foundational understanding of how materials can absorb energy from light, which causes them to change. Finally, we will end the week demonstrating their understanding of how light can change a material, including genetic material in skin cells.
